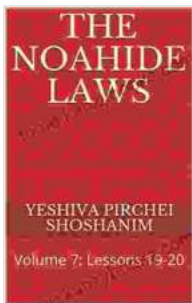

Kidnapping violates the fundamental right to liberty. It can lead to physical and psychological harm, instilling fear and distrust within society.

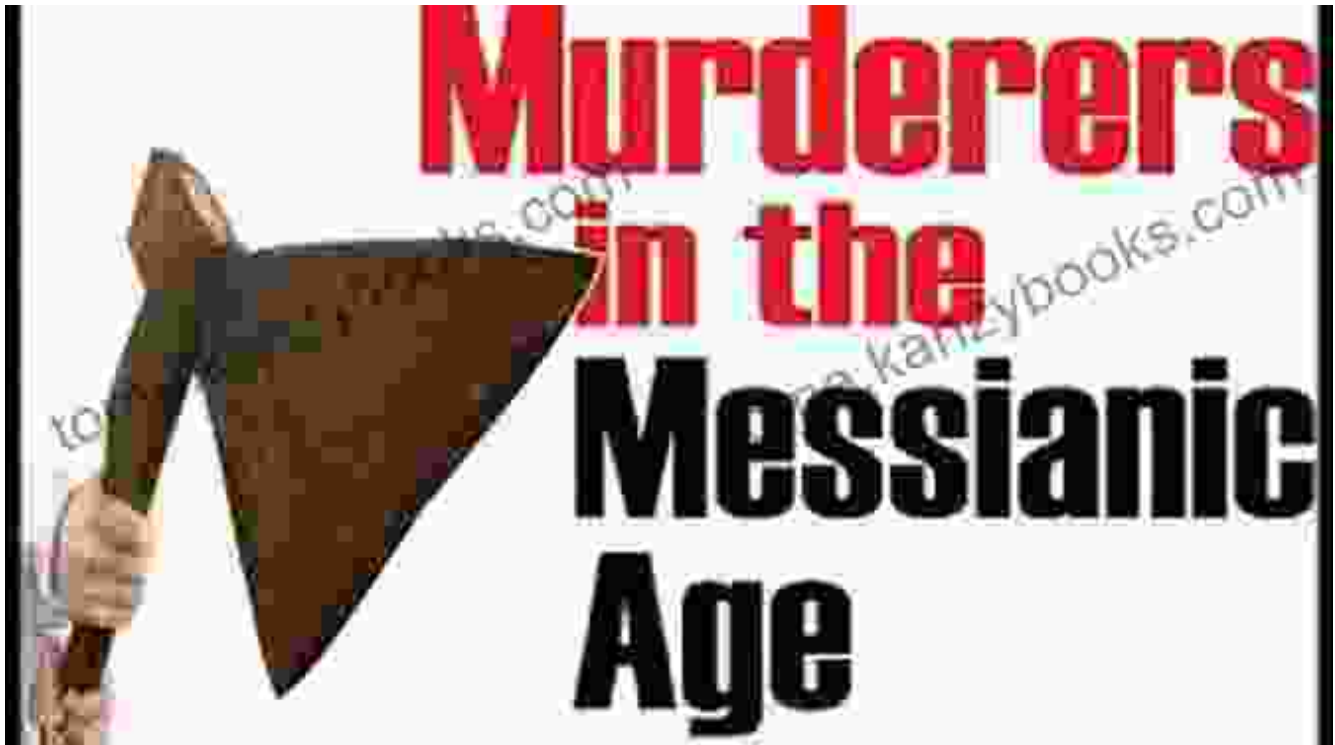

Lesson 21: The Prohibition against Bearing False Witness

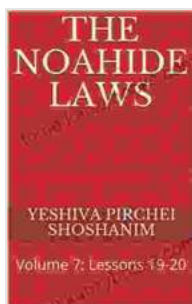
This law forbids lying under oath in a court of law, intentionally misleading the judicial process.
